For decades, the Federal City of Germany has been in the limelight as Germany's political platform, and the 2000-year-old city has a good reputation as an international congress location and culture destination. Lying at both sides of the strong Rhine river, Bonn has more than 300.000 citizens in front of the beautiful silhouette of the 'Siebengebirge'. This city is part of the ABC-Region (Aachen-Bonn-Cologne) which is a core area of research in Germany. Its cityscape is characterized by the university and her two historical castles. By a walk at the riverside visitors will realize Bonns international character as city of the UN demonstrated by the "Langer Eugen" building - solely overtopped by the "Post Tower", the highest skyscraper in North-Rhine Westfalia and a light-house of Bonns powerful economy.

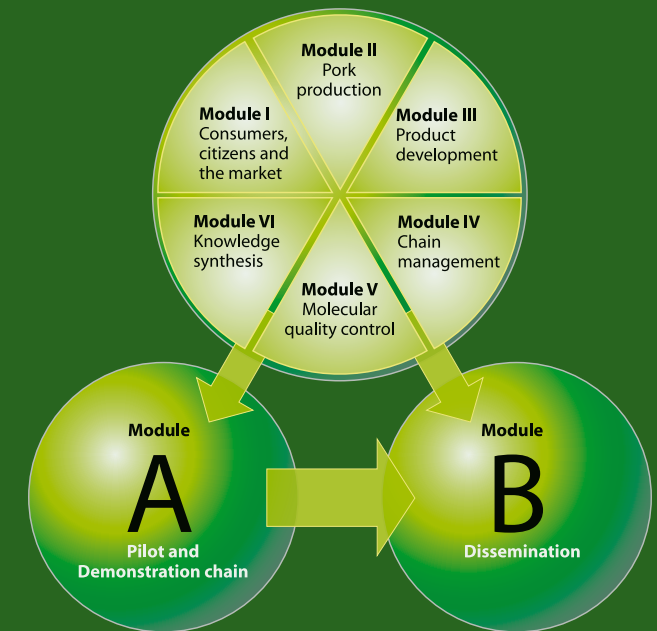
About Q-PorkChains
